Luella Stable's Objectives for students: To teach each student how to safely and properly enjoy horses from the ground as well as the horses back. Luella Stables teaches western riding, some jumping and occasionally bareback-riding. Each student starts on the most beginner horse and works their way up to more challenging horses. Each student learns to properly groom, tack and un-tack before and after riding. Students learn to bathe, exercise horses by lounge line, clean stalls and tack, feeding and basic healthcare for owning a horse. Students that wish to compete will learn rodeo events such as cones, barrels, and poles. Students are not pressured to compete. Students learn to ride solo and how to ride with others in the ring, on the trails, and fields. Each student learns at their own level according to the student's learning ability, athletic

ability and age. The more barn and saddle time a student gets the better equestrian he/she becomes. Luella Stables also offers day camps and week camps for consecutive hours of horses for students at the ages of 7-18. Students under 7 will be carefully assessed before being allowed to attend camp days. Boarding, family and friend group rides, and birthday parties are also available at Luella Stables.

Terms and Rules:

Parents and guests please do not enter the barn or interfere with the lesson.

Parents or guardians are responsible for guests. You are responsible for keeping guests and other children out of the barn, away from horses, out of the fields and OFF THE GATES AND FARM EQUIPMENT! Parents and/or Guardians are expected to supervise your children while at Luella Stables.
